### 'Island In The Sun Display'



A collection of over 400 items associated with more than 35 countries [African and Caribbean]. Youngsters gain an understanding of items used in the past whilst elders particularly benefit as it rekindles early memories. The 'Island In The Sun Display' focuses on the historical social and cultural aspects of home life and items produced by the countries in the display. It is available to book all year round.

### 'Island In The Sun Display' 3 ~ 5 Years Package

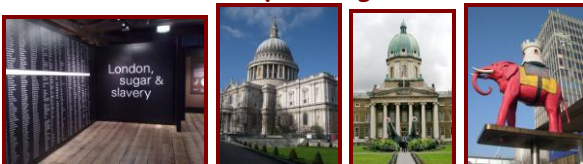

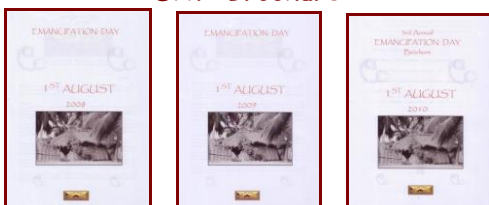
### Family Outings
